The Master program includes:

- 1) An introductory module, that will be held at the Universitas Miguel Hernandez de Elche from 26 to 29 September 2016

 - d. User perspectives in drug and alcohol treatment
 - e. Cultural and social aspects of drug and alcohol use
- 4) One intensive week organized by one of the partner universities
- 5) A not compulsory training in one of the partner university
- 6) The graduation ceremony at the EMCDDA in Lisbon.
