What are the main findings Member State by Member State?

These are just some of the key issues to come under the spotlight in the fourth *Annual Report on the State of the Drugs Problem in the European Union* from the Lisbon-based EU drugs information agency, the **EMCDDA**. The report will be launched at 12 noon (Central European Time) on Monday 22 November at the *Presse- und Informationsamt der Bundesregierung*, Berlin in the presence of German drugs co-ordinator, Christa Nickels, and EMCDDA Executive Director, Georges Estievenart.

The *Annual Report* is key to understanding the major features of the drug problem in Europe as well as the legal, political and social responses to it initiated within the **EU**.
