(8.10.2003 LISBON) Key issues on drugs in Europe are addressed in the **2003 Annual reports** out soon from the Lisbon-based **EU** drugs agency, the **EMCDDA**.

As in 2002, the EMCDDA is publishing two reports this year presenting overall trends and responses. The *Annual report 2003: the state of the drugs problem in the European Union and Norway* (available in the 11 EU languages + Norwegian) carries special issues on drug and alcohol use among young people; social exclusion and reintegration; and public expenditure in the area of demand reduction.

The Annual report 2003: the state of the drugs problem in the acceding and candidate countries to the European Union (available in English) offers three selected issues: drug and alcohol use among young people; drug-related infectious diseases; and national drug strategies.

Expanded online versions of the reports will appear simultaneously on dedicated websites: http://annualreport.emcdda.eu.int and http://candidates.emcdda.eu.int. These offer full downloadable PDF versions of the reports; news releases; and a wealth of additional material and statistics complementing and further illustrating the content of the printed versions.
