TDI data submitted to the EMCDDA in 2011

- Data collected from 30 countries;
- 69 valid Fonte reports;
 - 25 = Outpatient;
 - 23 = Inpatient;
 - 08 = Prison;
 - 07 = Low-threshold;
 - 03 = General Practitioner;
 - 04 = Other.
- More than 350.000 data points.

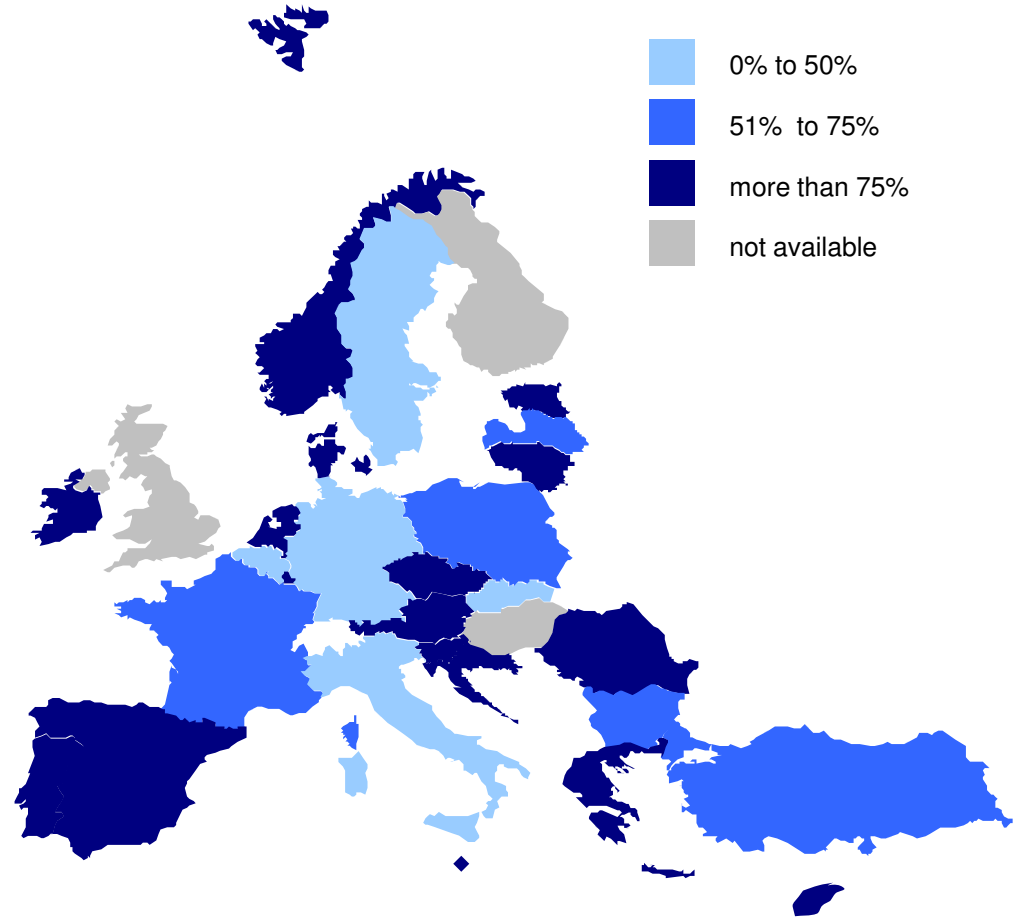
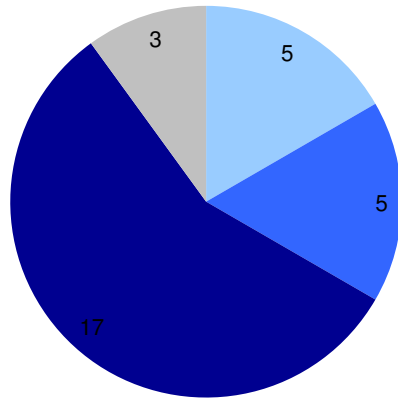
- N = 472 000
- Mean age = 32
- Gender ratio (m/f) = 4.1
- Mean age at first use = 21
- % injecting = 21.3%
- Opioids = 48%
- Cocaine = 15%
- Cannabis = 25%
- Stimulants = 6%
- Other = 6%

- New clients

- N = 178 000
- Mean age = 31
- Gender ratio (m/f) = 4.3
- Mean age at first use = 20
- % injecting = 12.5%
- Opioids = 30%
- Cocaine = 21%
- Cannabis = 37%
- Stimulants = 6%
- Other = 6%



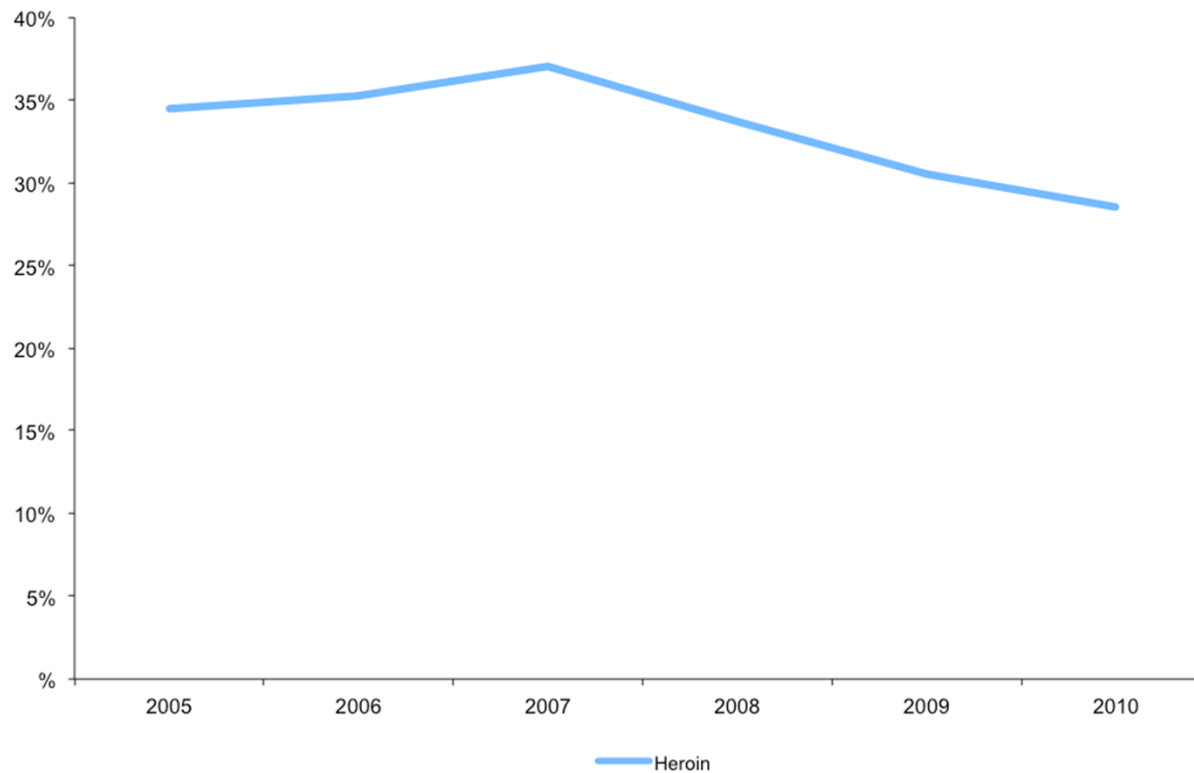
Coverage (percentage of units covered)



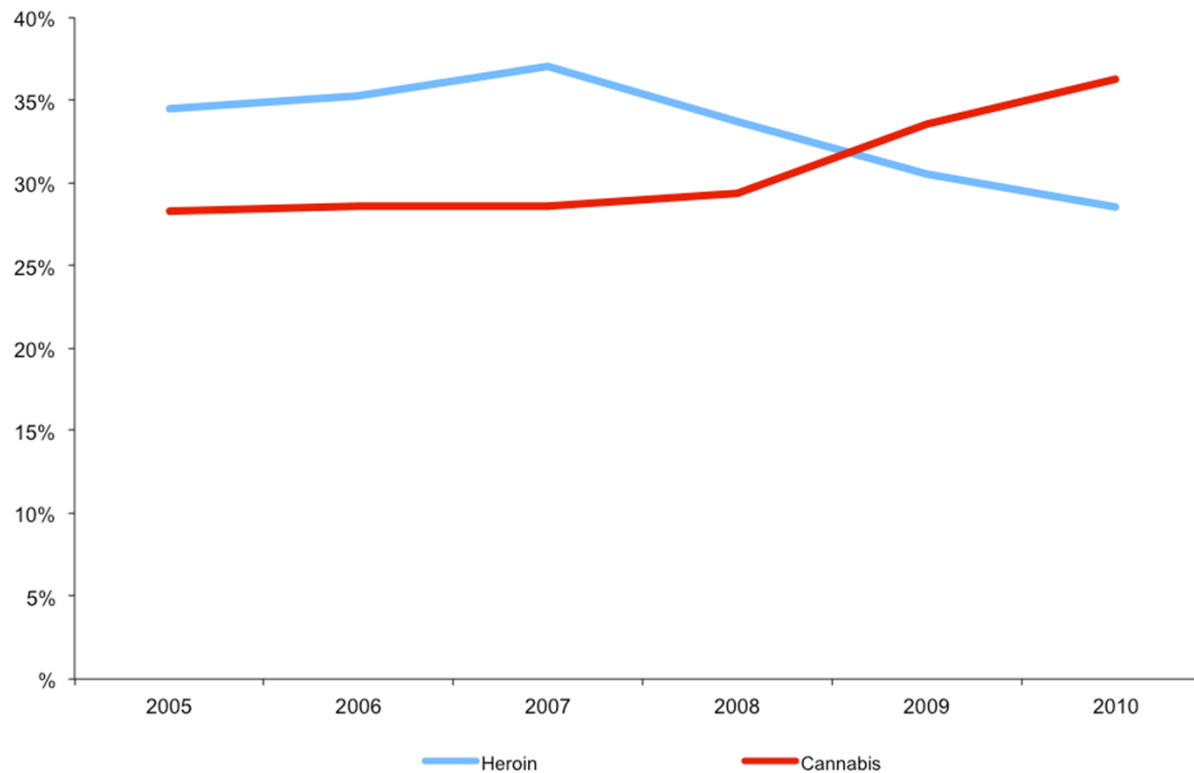
Trend of new clients entering treatment by primary drugs, 2005 to 2010



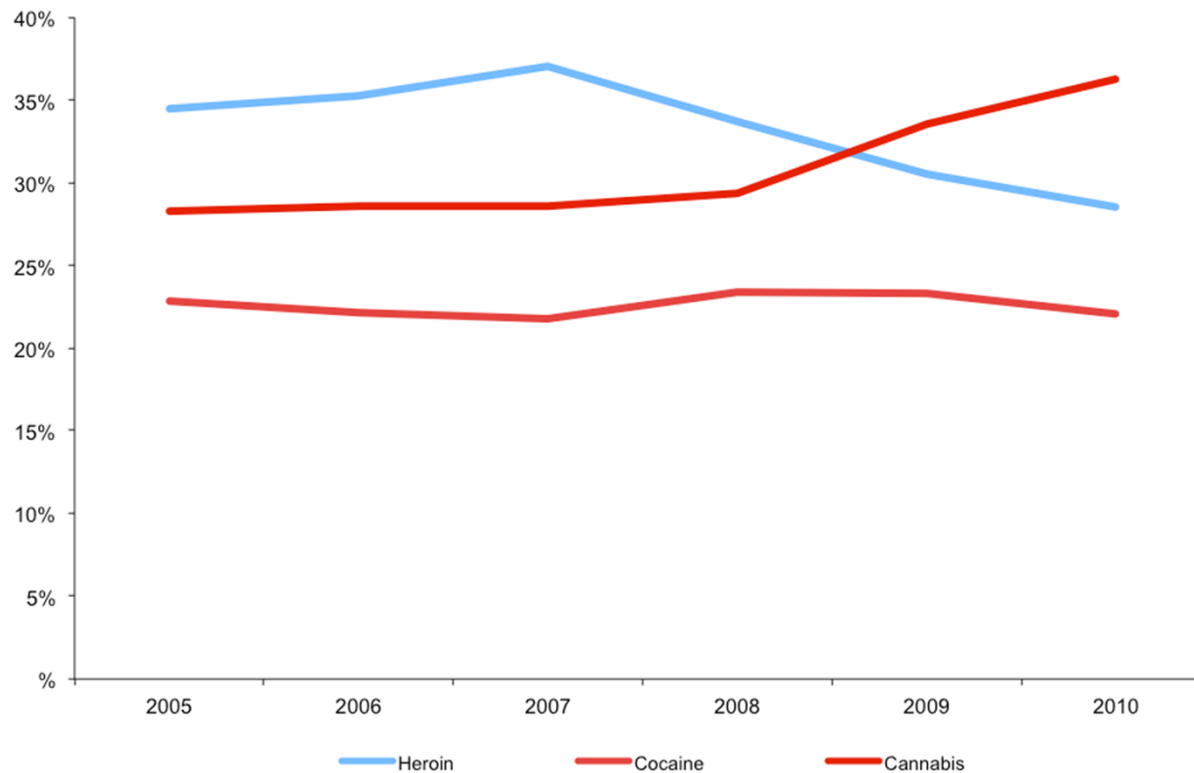
Trend of new clients entering treatment by primary drugs, 2005 to 2010



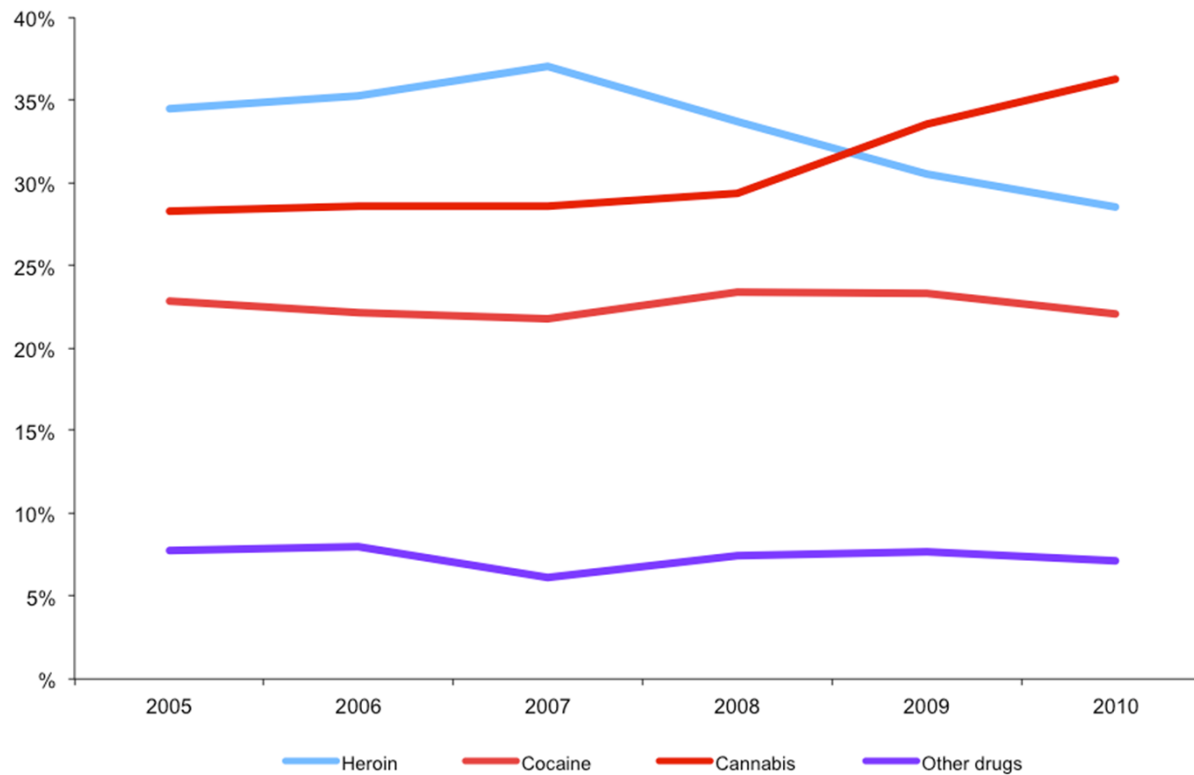
Trend of new clients entering treatment by primary drugs, 2005 to 2010



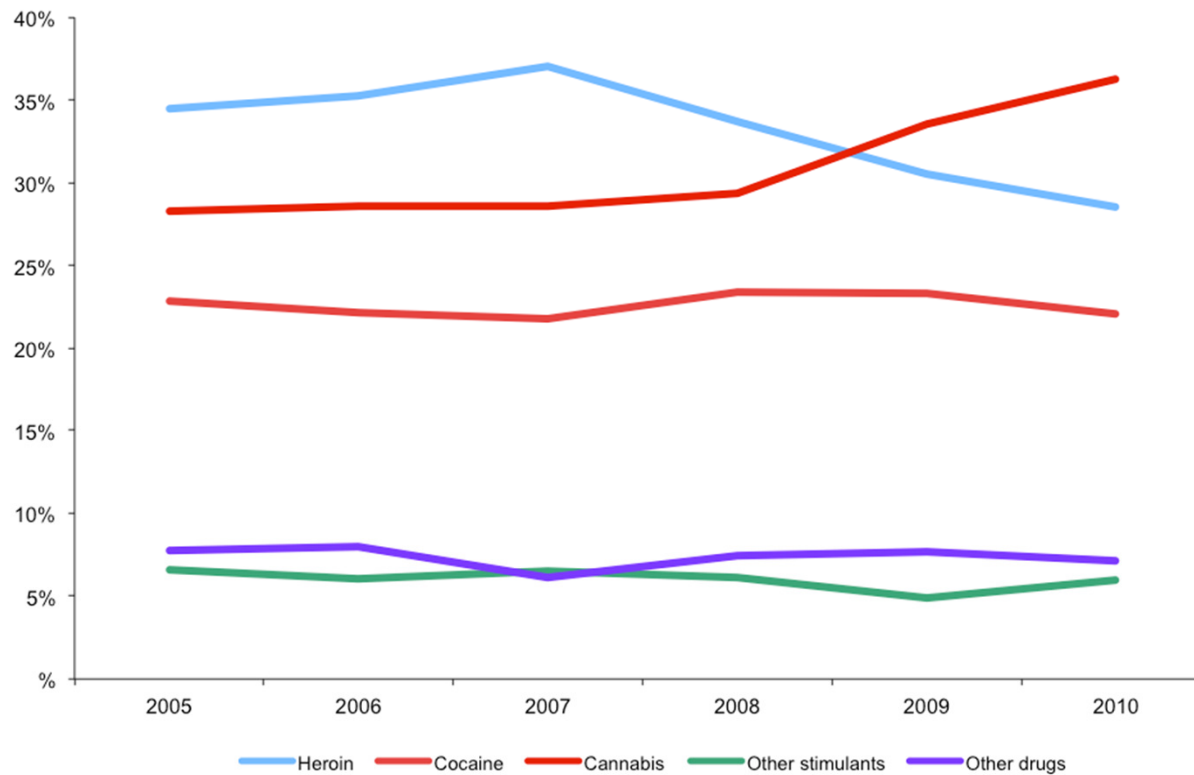

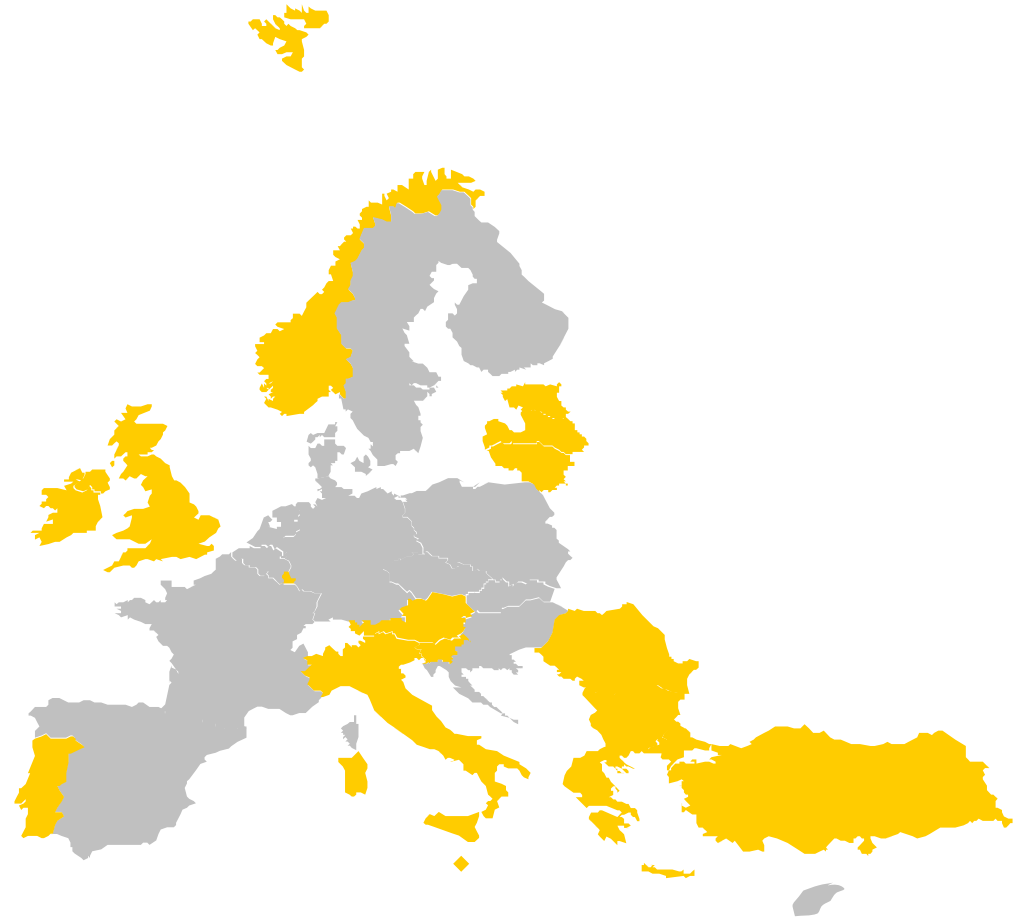
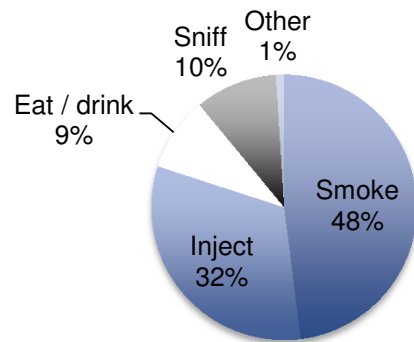
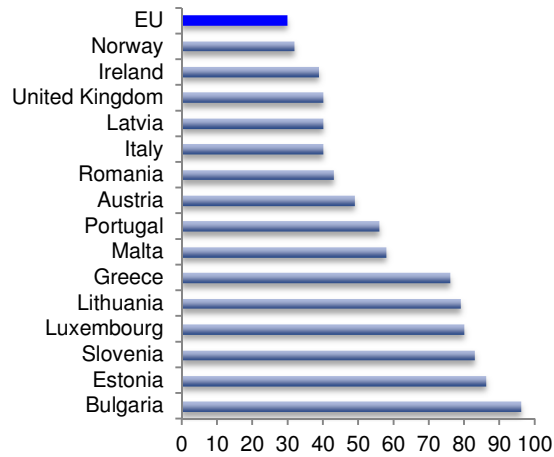
Trend of new clients entering treatment by primary drugs, 2005 to 2010



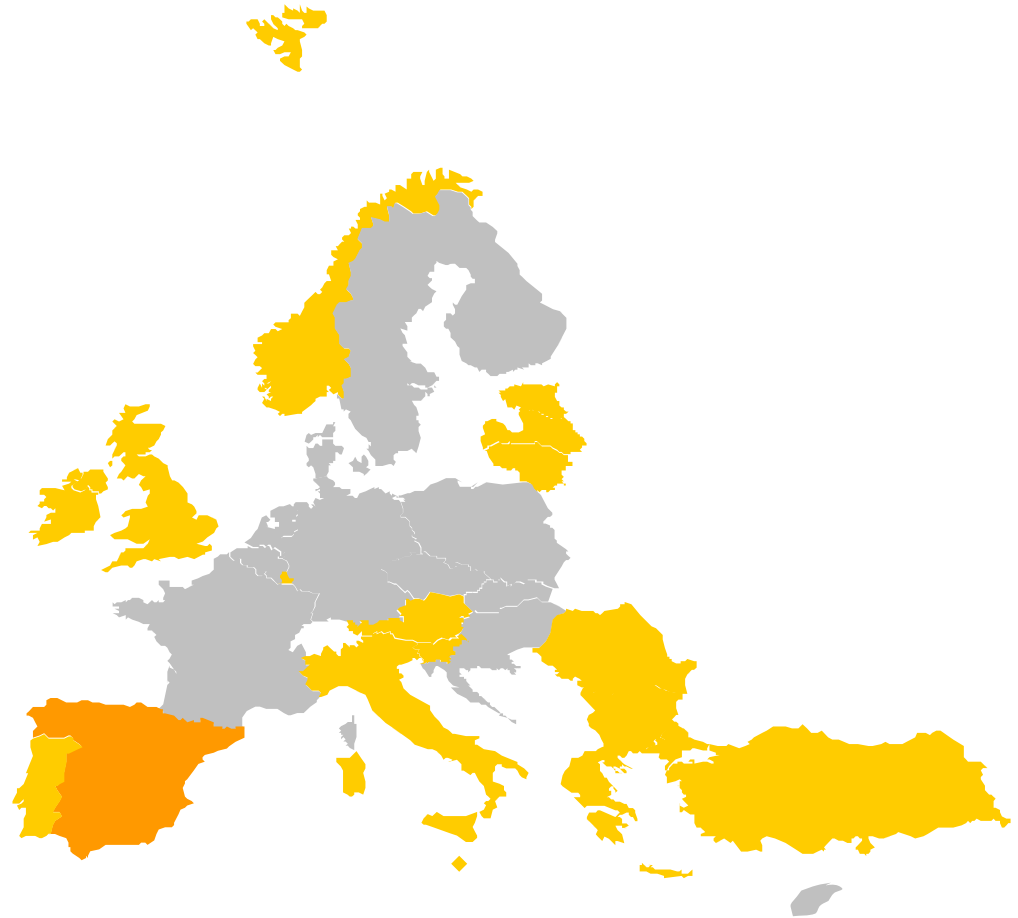
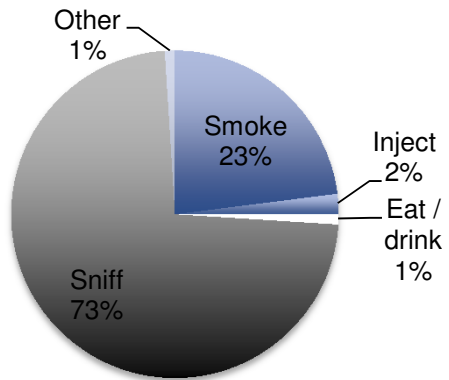
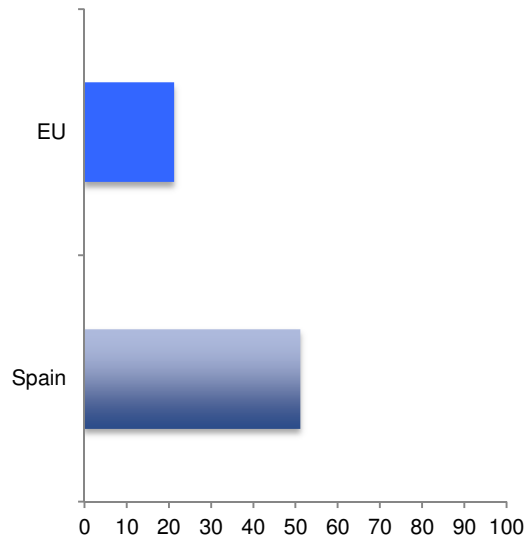
Trend of new clients entering treatment by primary drugs, 2005 to 2010



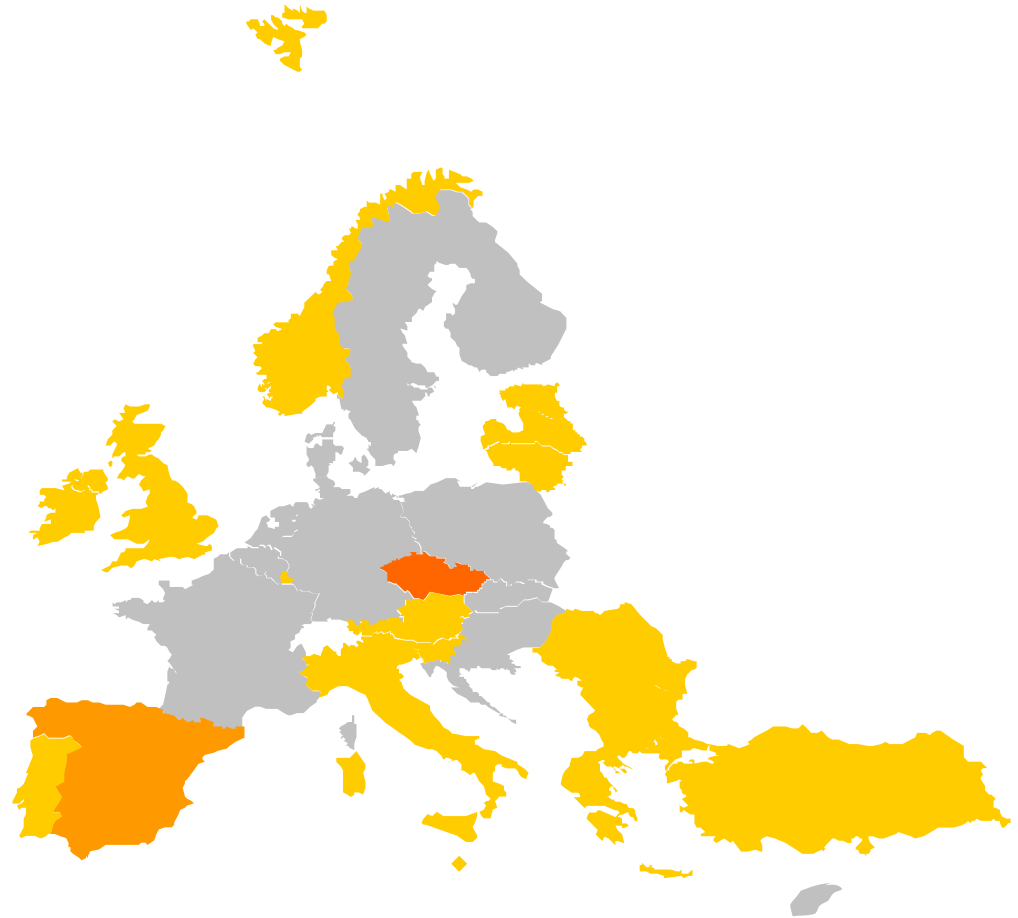
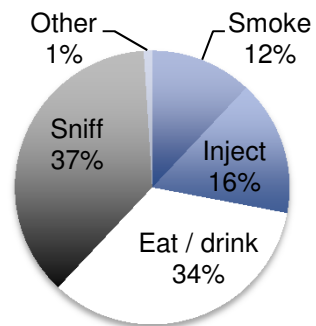
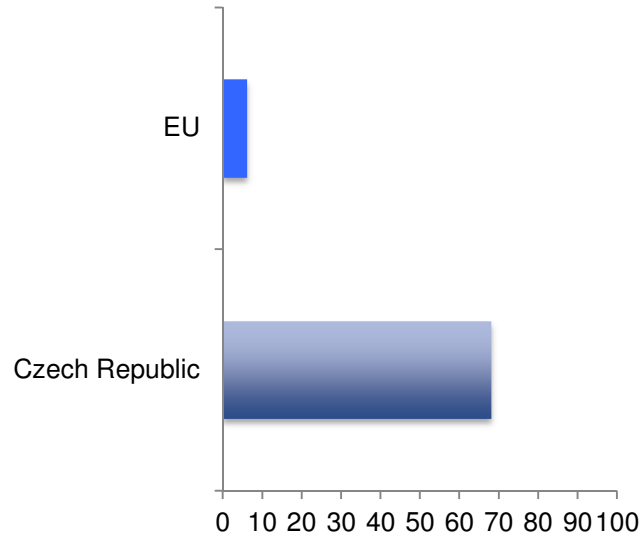
Countries where the highest percentage for primary drug is Opioids



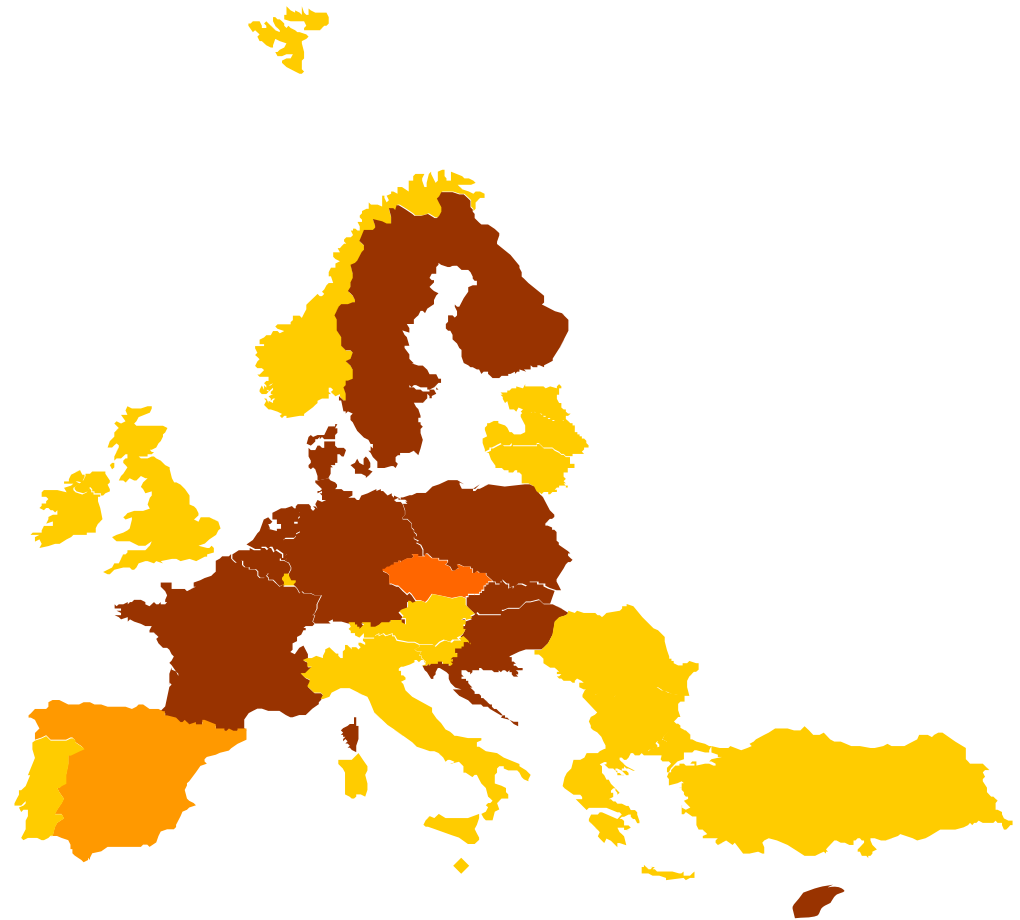
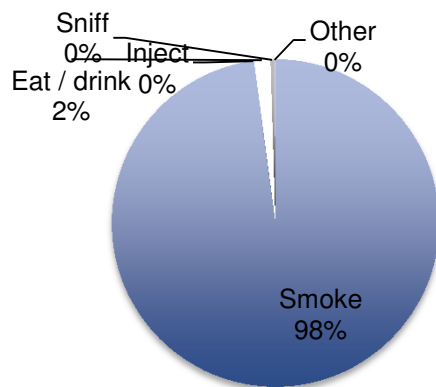
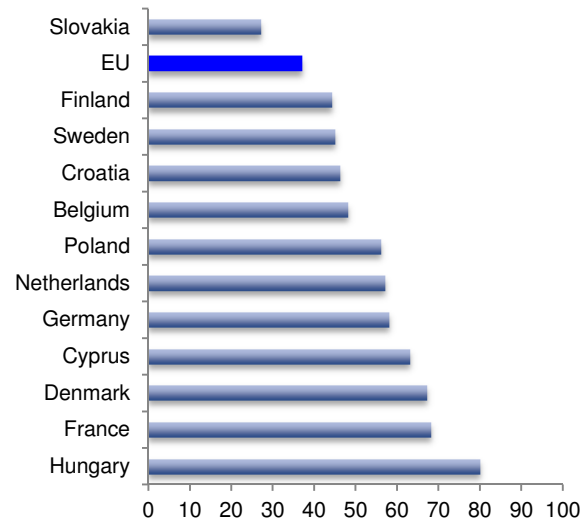
Countries where the highest percentage for primary drug is Cocaine



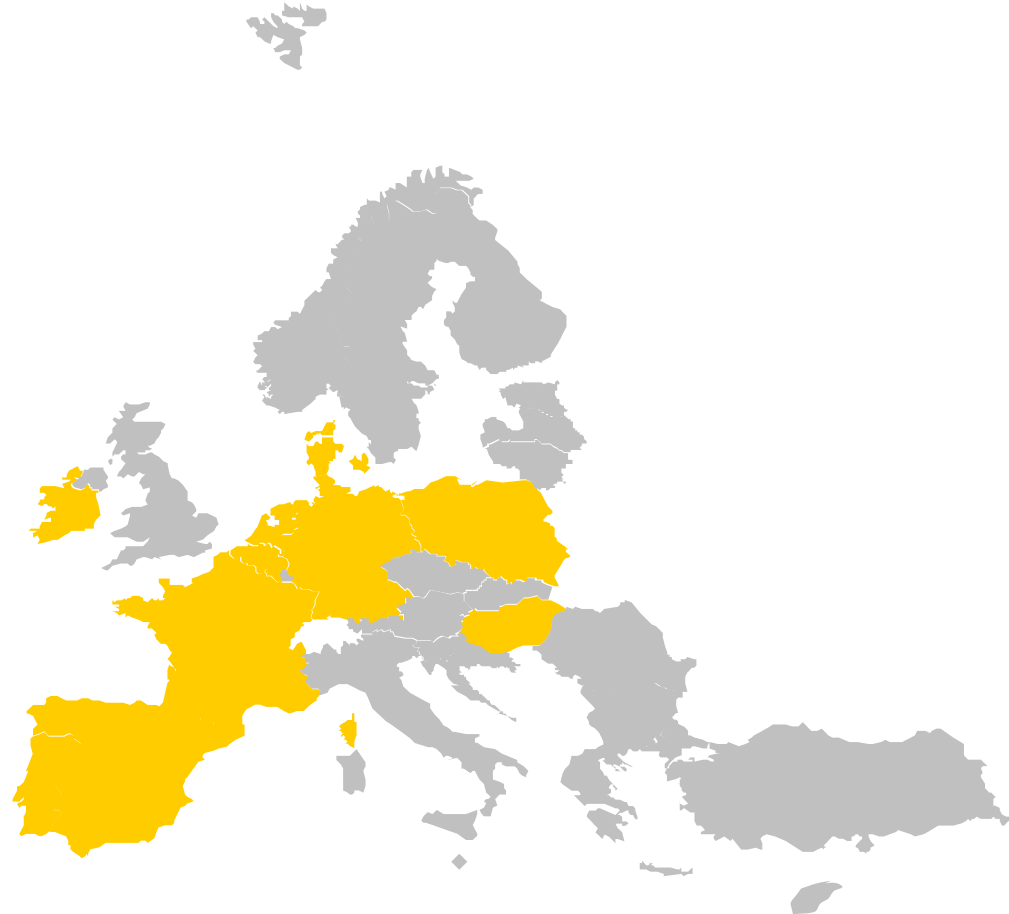
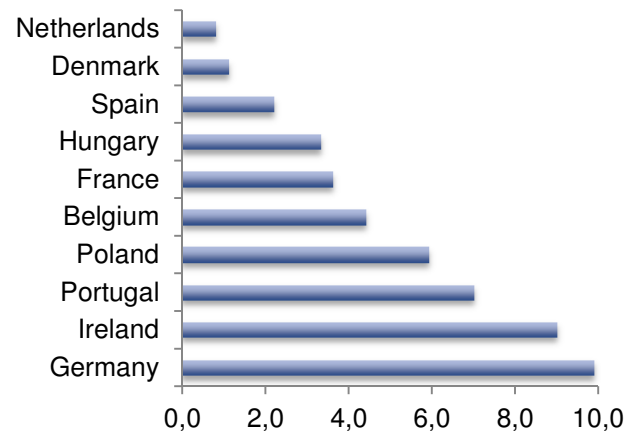
Countries where the highest percentage for primary drug is Stimulants



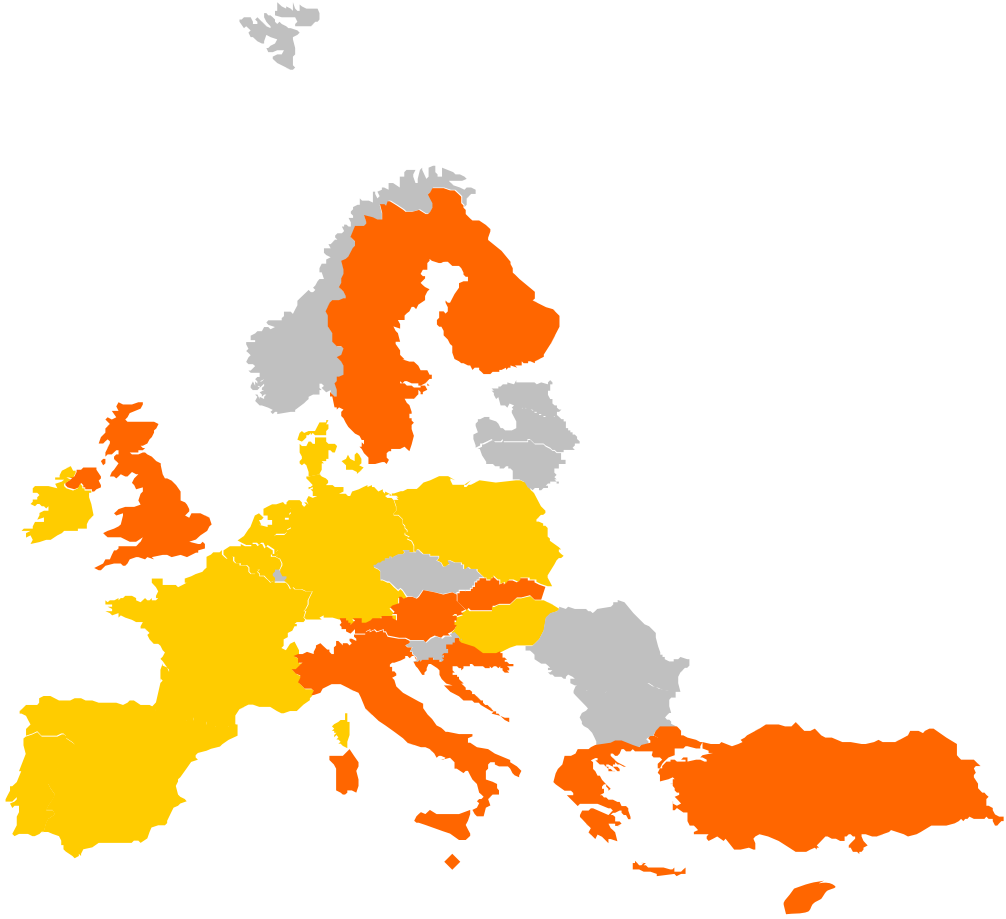
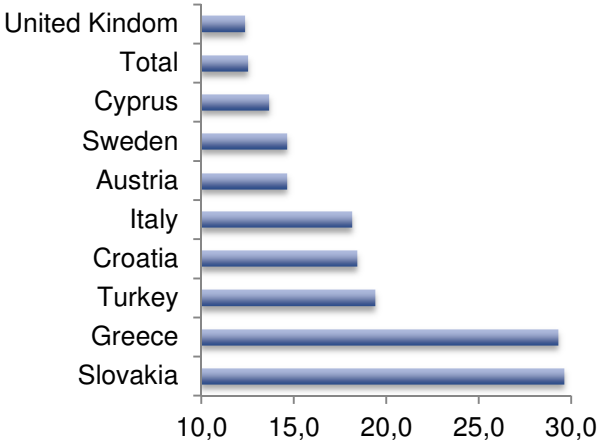
Countries where the highest percentage for primary drug is Cannabis



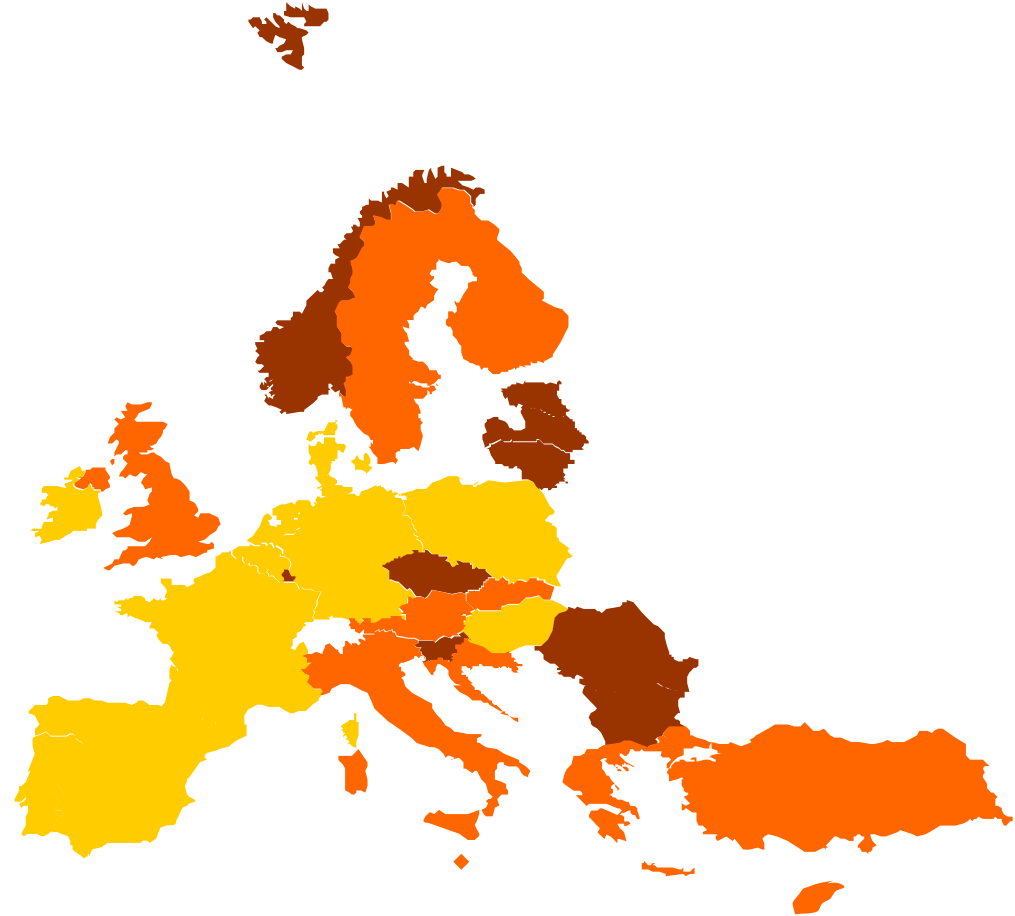
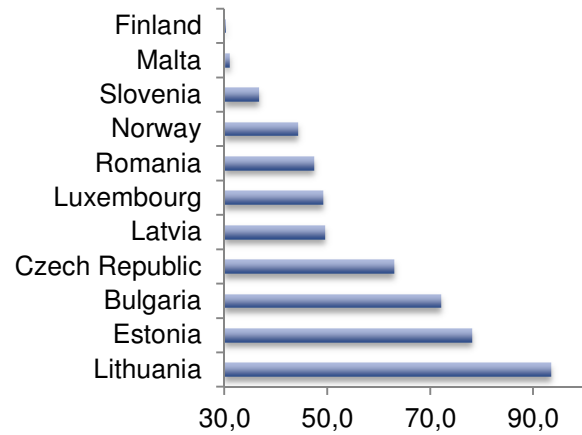
Rates of injection - countries with rates lower than 10%



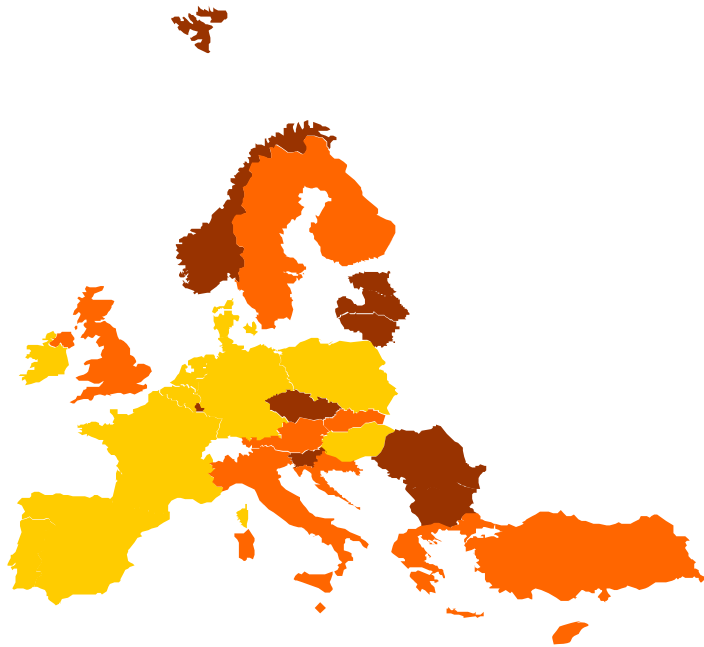
Rates of injection - countries with rates between 11% and 30%



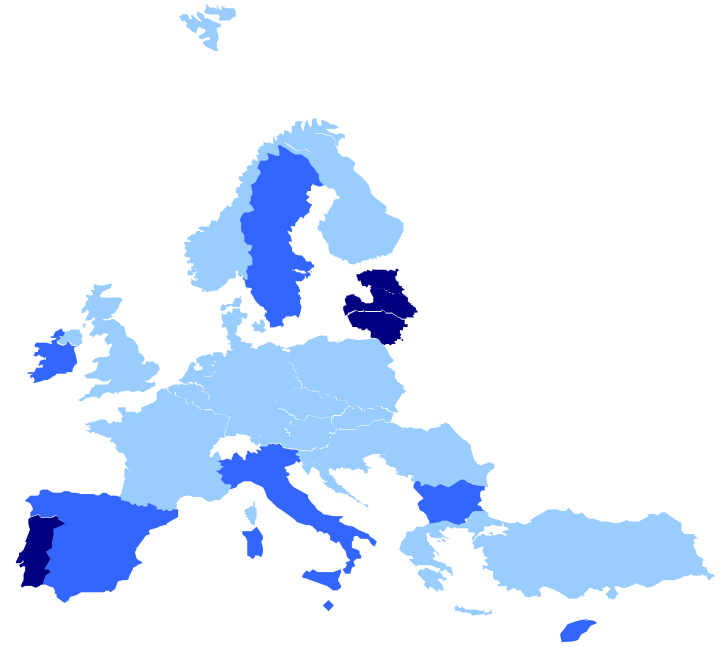
Rates of injection - countries with rates higher than 30%
