"Treatment demand for opioids is a disappearing problem in the Netherlands"


- Low and decreasing incidence rates

- Generation in Chronic care



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


Treatment demand primary problem opioids






Continuous, First, Previous Treatment






Opiates Substitution Treatment






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
GenerationAge distribution 1997 vs. 2011





Generation Mean age 1997-2011





population 2011 (N=11.387)



population 2011 (N=11.387)







Conclusions



Treatment demand for opioids in the Netherlands a disappearing problem?

On the long term with ongoing observed trends **Yes**:

- The TD for opioids is declining since 2000.
- Use in general population stable
- The incidence numbers are very small and decreasing; no new groups (so far)
- Generation in treatment is aging and will at long last extinct BUT

Conclusions



Treatment demand for opioids in the Netherlands a disappearing problem?

For the coming years: NO

 The number of elderly clients is rapidly growing together with related elderly problems

Policy questions:

- Existing care sufficient for extraordinary elderly group?
- Need for specialized elderly homes?



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Summery



- Ongoing decrease of total TD for opioids in the Netherlands
- Increase in age 55+
