






Total number of treatments reporting opioids other than heroin and methamphetamine as their primary drug of





Number of people starting treatment in a year reporting methamphetamine as their primary drug of abuse








2014: first estimate of methamphetamine high risk use central estimate 127 (range: 20-244)

→ 35% in treatment (compared to 24% of opiate users)

- Gender: 69% males (31), 31% females (14)
- First treatments: 42% (19/45)
- Type of treatment: even distribution (out- and inpatient)
- Most prevalent: two cities (mainly CY nationals)





- Mean duration of use: 2,9 years (stable since 2010) min. 1 year, max. 6 years
- Mean age at first use: 23,8 years (stable since 2010) min. 12 years of age, max. 39 years





• Usual route of administration:

smoke/ inhale (34/45)

• High risk use:

Ever injected - 15/45 (*increasing number since 2010*) Currently injecting: 6/45 Ever shared: 9/45 cannabis – cocaine – opioids (incl. heroin)



Number of people starting treatment in a year reporting opiates as their primary drug of abuse











Number of people starting treatment in a year reporting heroin as their primary drug of abuse
















- 2014: 50 out of a total of 62 opioid users (other than heroin) reporting Oxycodone as their primary drug of abuse
- ...-2013: no distinction between Oxycodone and other opioids







Estimate (per 1000 population 15-64 years of age) of problem opiate users per year














Age group distribution (%) of those reporting opioids other than heroin as their primary drug of abuse








Opioid users (other than heroin)



- Gender: 84% (42) males, 16% (8) females
- First treatments: 37% (same proportion of Oxycodone clients)
- Type of treatment: even distribution (slightly higher in outpatient)
 Most prevalent: one particular city (Limassol) (Oxycodone CY nationals)








Mean duration of use: 4,1 years years opioids, 2,1 years

Mean age at first use: 31,5 years (relatively stable)






• Usual route

of administration:24% injecting (Oxycodone: 20% injecting, 60% sniffing)


High risk use: Ever injected – 76% (increasing number since 2010)
 Currently injecting – 3/10
 Ever shared – 3/10 (2014 – only Oxycodone users)

• Polydrug use: Cannabis - heroin
